Sea Gayle/Arista Nashville recording artist Jerrod Niemann's current song, "What Do You Want," is the hit follow-up to his No. 1 smash single, "Lover, Lover." Niemann co-produced and was a writer on ten of the twelve songs on his acclaimed album, Judge Jerrod & The Hung Jury, one of *The New York Times'* Top 10 Albums of 2010. Upon release, the album debuted at No. 1 on Billboard's Top Country Albums sales chart and remained the only major label debut to hit No. 1 on the chart all year. Niemann's multiple award nominations in 2010 included his first CMA (Country Music Association) Award nomination as New Artist of the Year.



As the season-two winners of Country Music Television's *Can You Duet*, Steel Magnolia (Meghan Linsey and Joshua Scott Jones) captured America's hearts with the duo's dynamic harmony and music that is one-part country and two-parts southern soul. The band's top-15 hit, "Keep On Lovin' You," was the highest-charting debut single from a country duo in over three years, and their recent hit, "Last Night Again," currently is climbing the country charts. Steel Magnolia is a multiple 2010 Academy of Country Music Award nominee (overall Top Vocal Duo of the Year and Top New Vocal Duo) and has been featured nationally on Lopez Tonight, the The Early Show on CBS and Better TV.
