## MYLAN CLASSIC PRESENTED BY CONSOL ENERGY CONGRATULATES ROCCO MEDIATE AND JASON GORE

CANONSBURG, Pa – The Mylan Classic presented by CONSOL Energy congratulates Rocco Mediate and Jason Gore on their tournament wins this past weekend. Rocco Mediate won the Frys.com Open in San Martin, California while fellow Mylan Classic competitor Jason Gore won the Miccosukee Championship in Miami on Sunday for his record seventh Nationwide Tour title.

Rocco Mediate won the Frys.com Open by one stroke, highlighted by an eagle on 17 Par 4, hitting a pitching wedge from 116 yards that spun back into the cup on Sunday afternoon. This is Mediate's sixth PGA Tour title and first since 2002. With this win, Rocco earned \$900,000 and earned a two-year tour exemption.



On the other side of the continent, fellow Mylan Classic participant Jason Gore was making history winning the Miccosukee Championship for a record seventh Nationwide Tour title. Gore won by four strokes over Scott Gutschewski and Mylan Classic winner Kevin Kisner. Gore finished at 16 under and earned \$108,000 to jump from 124th to 39th on the money list with \$141,451. The top 60 after the Jacksonville Open next week will qualify for the season-ending Tour Championship and the final top 25 will earn 2011 PGA Tour cards.

Mediate, a Greensburg, PA native competed in the Mylan Classic along side Gore, whose mother was born and raised in Turtle Creek, PA. The Mylan Classic was one of four new events on the PGA TOUR's 29-event Nationwide Tour in 2010. The Golf Channel televised all four rounds of the Mylan Classic in the U.S. Internationally, it was distributed via the PGA TOUR to 72 countries, including Japan, China, Korea, Hong Kong and parts of Europe and Latin America.
